This will acknowledge your application for appointment to the office of Notary Public-Special Commission.


A notary public state at large is a resident or nonresident of Kentucky (who must be principally employed in Kentucky) who is appointed to perform notarial acts within the state of Kentucky, but these documents can go to other states for recording.

A special commission notary is a resident or nonresident of Kentucky who is appointed by the Governor of Kentucky to perform notarial acts inside or outside this state covering documents to be recorded in this state only.

To complete the process, please take the enclosed oath of office before a Judge, Clerk of a Court, Notary Public, or Justice of the Peace (Magistrate) and have the oath administered. Upon our receipt of your executed oath of office, the Governor will issue your commission to office as a Notary Public-Special Commission.

Please note: The oath of office must be administered and the form completed and returned to our office before **June 18, 2009**. Please return to:
