1 AN ACT relating to military affairs.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 → Section 1. KRS 36.085 is amended to read as follows:

4 (1) It is the intent of the General Assembly to provide a local ***installation*** management
5 fund at ***Department of Military Affairs facilities***~~[the Kentucky National Guard~~
6 ~~armories]~~. The local ***installation*** management fund shall be receipts from the use of
7 ***Department of Military Affairs***~~[National Guard]~~ facilities by ***military and***~~[local]~~
8 nonmilitary ***individuals and*** organizations.

9 (2) The General Assembly further recognizes that ***some Department of Military Affairs***
10 ***facilities***~~[the National Guard armories]~~ are not staffed by state employees, but are
11 staffed by members of the Kentucky National Guard, who are on the federal payroll.
12 It is the intent of the General Assembly to authorize the adjutant general of
13 Kentucky to appoint a member of the Kentucky National Guard as custodian of
14 each of the various local ***installation*** management funds ***when an authorized state***
15 ***employee is not stationed at that location.***

16 → Section 2. KRS 36.086 is amended to read as follows:


17 (1) The Department of Military Affairs may establish an installation management fund
18 account in a local bank for each ***Department of Military Affairs facility***~~[National~~
19 ~~Guard armory]~~ notwithstanding KRS 41.070 and 45A.655. Funds derived from the
20 use of the buildings and grounds~~[by local civic and other nonmilitary organizations~~
21 ~~for receptions, meetings, and other events]~~ shall be deposited in the ***Department of***
22 ***Military Affairs local installation management fund*** account.

23 (2) The adjutant general shall determine the maximum authorized balance in each
24 ***Department of Military Affairs***~~[armory's]~~ local installation management fund
25 account. The adjutant general or his designated representative shall review at least
26 annually each installation management fund account. If the account balance is
27 excessive, the surplus funds shall be withdrawn from the installation management


- 1 fund account for deposit in the appropriate Department of Military Affairs trust and
 2 agency fund account.
- 3 (3) The local installation management fund account shall be used for~~miscellaneous~~
 4 ~~maintenance and repairs and other services and equipment~~ expenses associated
 5 with routine Department of Military Affairs and Kentucky National Guard
 6 functions and~~armory~~ operations. Any expense in excess of one hundred and fifty
 7 dollars ~~(\$150)~~~~(\$50)~~ but not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) shall have
 8 approval from the facilities division director. Any expense in excess of one
 9 thousand dollars (\$1,000) but not more than two thousand five hundred dollars
 10 (\$2,500) shall have approval from the executive director of the Department of
 11 Military Affairs. Any expense in excess of two thousand five hundred dollars
 12 (\$2,500) but not more than four thousand dollars (\$4,000) shall have approval
 13 from the adjutant general or his designated representative.
- 14 (4) The adjutant general shall provide an annual report to the Legislative Research
 15 Commission and the secretary of the Finance and Administration Cabinet which
 16 identifies the receipts and expenditures of the installation management fund
 17 accounts. This report shall be transmitted to the Legislative Research Commission
 18 and the secretary of the Finance and Administration Cabinet within sixty (60) days
 19 after the close of each fiscal year. In addition, the adjutant general shall also provide
 20 information to the Legislative Research Commission and the secretary of the
 21 Finance and Administration Cabinet during the preparation of the biennial budget
 22 relating to the receipts, expenditures and balances of these accounts.
