PARDON & COMMUTATION

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

WHEREAS, Kathy Ann Harless was convicted in Grayson County in 2003 of murder and tampering with physical evidence; and

WHEREAS, Kathy Harless has paid enough for the death of her new-born son:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Matthew G. Bevin, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, in consideration of the foregoing, and by the virtue of the authority vested in me by Sections 77, 145, and 150 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, do hereby commute the sentence of Kathy Ann Harless to time served and pardon her for all charges directly related to her current incarceration.
